



## High School Supplies & Materials List 2020-21 – Grades 9-12 (updated 7/24/20)

*Please bring all supplies to school on the first day.*

*Supplies should be replaced as needed throughout the school year.*

The Following items are used throughout the year and may need to be replenished.

- Notebook paper - college ruled
- Tab dividers (sets) for all subjects
- Highlighters (3 colors)
- 3x5 cards, lined, provide as needed
- Pencils, pens, erasers, highlighters
  - Red correcting pens (2)
- Colored pencils (8-12 ct.)
- Ruler (metric and inches)
- Plain brown paper book covers- All textbooks must be covered. (Grocery bags and brown parcel paper are the sturdiest) Purchased fabric covers or sticky adhesive covers may not be used.
- Sheet Protectors, box of 100-200 to supply all classes and homeroom binder
- Stapler and staples (to be kept at home)
- Paper Cutter: It is suggested that each family have a paper cutter at home for projects and reports (9 x 12 at minimum).
- 2 large boxes of tissues (to be given to homeroom teacher on the first day of school)
- USB memory drive to be used for various classes
- <sup>1</sup>**View Binder** – All 3-ring binders should be *View Binders* with a clear front pocket
- Clorox wipes (to be kept at desk) and hand sanitizer (backpack)
