The Following items are used through out the year and may need to be replenished.

- 2" 3-ring binder
- Notebook paper - college ruled, (stored in 3-ring binder)
- Tab dividers (sets) for all subjects

- Pencils, pens, erasers, highlighters
- Red correcting pens (2)
